Join Us for Shavuot at Anshe Emet
Saturday, May 26 beginning at 6 pm

We have traditionally joined with the Kehillah congregations for the Tikkun Leyl Shavuot, which will be held this year at Anshe Emet, 3751 N Broadway. Shavuot is traditionally associated with the Revelation at Sinai and our receiving the Torah. One of the special traditions of this day is the all-night learning of the Tikkun Leyl Shavuot, in which Or Chadash has participated. In past years, we have held our own pre-Shavuot study session, but this year we have the opportunity to join with Anshe Emet to learn with their Scholar-in-Residence, Rabbi Reuven Hammer, a conservative Jewish rabbi, scholar of Jewish liturgy, author and lecturer. He is a founder of the Masorti movement in Israel and a past president of the International Rabbinical Assembly. He served many years as head of the Masorti Beth Din in Israel. A prolific writer in both the Israeli and international press, he is a regular columnist for The Jerusalem Post's "Tradition Today" column. He lives in Jerusalem. Hammer earned his doctorate in theology and his rabbinical ordination from the Jewish Theological Seminary.

There will be a **dinner at 7:30** at which Rabbi Hammer will teach. We are invited to join, but need to let Anshe Emet know how many are coming.
